PREREGISTRATION DATES

- Preregistration is Monday, July 6- Monday, August 10. We do not offer in-person preregistration.
- Forms will be accepted via email starting at 9:00 a.m. Any forms submitted before 9:00 a.m. on July 6 will be processed at the end of the day.

PREREGISTRATION ELIGIBILITY

- Preregistration is open to those students enrolled in the spring 2020 or summer 2020 semester and new students enrolling in
 classes that do not require prerequisites. New students wishing to enroll in a higher level course will need to set up a meeting
 with the dean for a counseling session on Tuesday, August 11, 2020. Please email glassell@mfah.org or call 713-639-7500
 between the hours of 10am and 1pm Mon-Fri to set up an appointment.
- Forms will be made available to students via the Glassell Studio School website at mfah.org/studentforms.

COMPLETION OF FORMS

• STUDIO COURSE ENROLLMENT FORMS:

- Students enrolling in studio courses that require prerequisites must have had taken the prerequisites for that course at Glassell or another institution. Alternatively, students may request permission and include these permissions from the instructor of the course, or have the permission of the dean of students.
- Students wishing to enroll in an online course must check the box provided on the spring 2020 registration form. Forms submitted without a check box selected will not be processed. Students who enroll in an online course will not be provided parking validation for the semester, and are not permitted to attend the in-person class.
- For a class listed as "by permission of the instructor only" (indicated by three asterisks *** on the class schedule), the signature of the instructor, or an email of approval from said instructor for that particular class must be included or attached to the form.
- Forms must include the student's signature in the designated box, acknowledging Studio School policies and guidelines.

PAYMENT

- The Glassell School of Art does not offer payment plans. All tuition must be PAID IN FULL at the time of registration.
- Forms must be submitted complete with payment, including credit card numbers. If you would like to make your payment over the phone, please include your telephone number in the provided section on the enrollment form so that administrators may call for your information. Administration will be available Mon-Fri, 10 a.m. through 1 p.m. to answer your questions and take your card information.

ADDING/DROPPING/WITHDRAWING

- Students wishing to add or drop a class must complete an add/drop form, available at mfah.org/glassell and email the form to registration@mfah.org. All courses are considered closed after the first class meeting, and permission of the instructor is required to add into a course. Additional tuition charges and refunds are processed as appropriate.
- Any student submitting more than one (1) add/drop form per semester (to switch a class) will be charged a processing fee of \$50 for each additional form submitted. Students dropping a class must inform the registrar and complete an add/drop form. Drop notices must be received by the school one (1) week prior to the posted start date of the semester. Refunds will be processed for the full amount of tuition, minus a \$100 processing fee. After the drop date, which is listed in the calendar for each semester, no credits or refunds are given.
- Refunds are processed through the MFAH accounting department and, in most cases, are processed through the original
 method of payment. In cases where the student's credit card was swiped in the original transaction, the school does not
 maintain swiped credit card information on file. Refunds in these situations will be processed by check. Refunds by check are
 sent via U.S. mail and may take up to three (3) weeks to process.
- The school does not offer prorated refunds or credits for individual sessions of courses or workshops that are canceled for
 reasons beyond the school's control, such as weather or unexpected absence of the instructor.
